Lot Decorating: It is our favourite time of year at Happy Hills....HALLOWEEN! Help the park get in the Halloween spirit by decorating your site for all to see.

Trick or Treating: On Saturday August 17th children aged 12 and under are invited to dress up and roam the streets of Happy Hills for our annual Trick or Treating night! It will take place from 7:00pm-8:00pm. If you wish to give out candy, please place a table at the end of your site for your treats. We ask the campers to only stop at sites with the tables to respect those who do not wish to participate. The store, Par-Tee Shack and Driving Range will also be joining, so don't forget about us! As a reminder to all, the Retirement Village does not partake in this event so please stay within the main park.

Garbage Control: We understand that you are on holidays when camping but we would appreciate if everyone took a second to walk to the nearest garbage can to dispose their snack garbage and water bottles. Primarily we ask those at the large bouncy pillow to be considerate and use the garbage bin placed immediately outside the fence door. We also ask that those who are smoking outside the pool area under the trees to take an extra second and place it in our cigarette butt stop by the pool door instead of on the ground. In order to keep our park and environment clean it is always best to recycle and clean up after yourselves.

Recycling Program: We would like to thank Alex from site 38 who has been working diligently with our recycling program to help keep this area tidy and making sure everything is in its proper container. Alex collects empty alcohol containers and pop cans which he recycles and the money he collects is put back into the park and supports some of the activities we offer. So, when you see him sorting at the recycling center, he is doing it on behalf of Happy Hills and the programs we run!

Family Hot Tub: Just a reminder that the Family Hot Tub is for children 6 years and older. Children under this age are not permitted in the hot tub and the lifeguards will ask them to leave. The hot tub is NOT to be used as a swimming pool; children are not to be going under water. If the lifeguards see children doing this they will be asked to leave. The hot tubs are not supervised, it is always the parents' responsibility to watch their children.

Golf Cart Speeding: We have noticed that within the park the golf carts are beginning to drive at excessive speeds. Please be considerate of our park rules and others walking within the park and slow down.

Respecting Neighbours: We were made aware that campers were walking between seasonal and transients' sites. This is not permitted as the only site you are able to walk through is your own

Helmets in the Park: Our park rules state children under 18 are required to wear helmets by law. We want everyone to be safe.

Pets: Just a reminder that they must always be on a leash and you must clean up after them. We do have the off-leash park for their enjoyment.

Campers Helping Campers Board: In the store you will find 2 bulletin boards where campers are welcome to post business cards for whatever service they provide. Feel free to take a look and contact your fellow Happy Hills campers when you are in need!

Sunday Yard Work: A reminder that on Sundays you are not permitted to use power tools or lawn mowers. Please respect your neighbours and keep the park peaceful on Sundays.

Golf Cart Inspections: If you are bringing a new golf cart into the park, we do require an inspection. Doug Garner will be doing the inspections in the park for a fee of \$20.00. Please stop by the office to talk to us or pick up a copy of our golf cart rules and regulations if you have any questions! Jack (who helps with the golf cart inspections every 2 years) will be working with us to ensure that the rules and regulations of our golf cart drivers are being followed in a safe manner and the golf carts meet our standards. If Jack does come and talk to you, he is representing Happy Hills.

*** Just a reminder that the use of cannabis products and alcohol consumption is not allowed off your campsite.
