**Flea Market:** The annual flee market is this Saturday! If you have not signed up, it is not too late to do so. Due to table availability, if you have not signed up yet you will be required to bring your own table.

**Family Hot Tub:** Just a reminder that the Family Hot Tub is for children 6 years and older. Children under this age are not permitted in the hot tub and the lifeguards will ask them to leave. They are too small, and it puts their bodies at greater risk of overheating from the warm temperature. The hot tub is **NOT** to be used as a swimming pool; children **are not** to be going under water. If the lifeguards, see children doing this they will be asked to leave. If you are uncertain about the rules, please check with the lifeguards or come to the office and we will be happy to review the rules with you. The hot tubs are not supervised by the lifeguards, they will monitor them periodically, but it is always the parents' responsibility to watch their children.

**Recycling Program:** We would like to thank Alex from site 38 who has been working diligently with our recycling program to help keep this area tidy and making sure everything is in its proper container. While doing this, he sorts and collects pop cans which he squishes one by one and then takes them to the recycling depot. He also collects liquor containers and beer cans, sorts them and takes them to the beer store for recycling. The money that Alex collects is put back into the park and supports some of the activities we offer. He has supported a number of Kids Klubs, the Ladies Golf Fun Night, the Neil Barker Memorial Youth Golf Tournament and also donates to the Embro Fire Department when they come on Labour Day weekend.
