Youth Fishing Derby: Head over to the store Friday to sign up for the youth fishing derby! The derby will be taking place Saturday, June 22nd, starting at 8:00am. Make your way over to the petting zoo gates during your time slot. Fishing rods will be provided. Anyone 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Please note: this will be weather permitting – if there are thunderstorms the fishing derby will be postponed to Sunday, June 23th at the same times you have signed up for.

Colouring Sheets: Hey kids! Make sure to stop by the store to pick up some 80's themed colouring sheets.

Day Passes: We do not allow you to leave day passes in the store for your guests. It becomes too busy in the store for our staff to keep track of who's day passes are who's. If you wish to have visitors in the park, we ask you meet your guests when they arrive with the passes. Thanks for your cooperation.

Mini Golf: The course is open during the store hours listed below. Our mini golf course is \$5.00 per game per person, along with a \$5.00 deposit per person for the club and ball. A friendly reminder, we DO NOT allow you to use your own club and ball on our course.

Golf Course: The golf course is open daily from dawn to dusk for members and pre-paid tickets, apart from league play and tournaments (which are posted on the Happy Hills Resort Golf Facebook page). Everyone must sign the book on the deck when entering the Golf Course when the Par-Tee Shack is not open.

Sharing Library: Our Sharing Library is set up in the store with a variety of books and DVD's. Stop in and take a book or DVD and share a book or DVD.

CampON: Remember to download the Camping in Ontario app, favourite Happy Hills and turn on your notifications to receive updates about events taking place in the park and what Happy Hills has to offer!

Campers Helping Campers Board: In the store you will find a bulletin board where campers are welcome to post their business cards to promote their business. Feel free to look and contact your fellow Happy Hills campers when you are in need!

Sunday Yard Work: A reminder that on Sundays you are not permitted to do any construction, use power tools or lawn mowers. Please respect your neighbours and keep the park peaceful on Sundays.

Garbage and Recycling: Please make sure all large items (i.e., mattresses, BBQs etc.) are taken home and <u>NOT</u> left at our dumpsters. We would also appreciate that you break down your boxes to maximize space in our recycle bins.

Pet Policy: All dog owners in the park MUST have their pets on a leash – even when on your site. We have a leash free dog park where your dog can run free but that is the ONLY area where this is permitted. If the dogs are reported off leash, you will be asked to remove your dog from the park. Also please remember to clean up after your dogs! Plastic bags for your dog's waste can be found at the dog parks.

Helmets in the Park: Our Park Rules state children under 18 are required to wear helmets by law. We want everyone to be safe here at Happy Hills!

*** Just a reminder that alcohol cannot be consumed off your campsite.
