Driving Range: A friendly reminder that the driving range is open from 9:00am-7:00pm daily. The bucket you purchased is to be utilized once – it is prohibited to EVER go on the driving range to pick up balls and refill your basket OR bring any balls or baskets home. Please respect the driving range.

Day Passes: We do not allow you to leave day passes in the store for your guests. It becomes too busy in the store for our staff to keep track of who's day passes are who's. If you wish to have visitors in the park, we ask you meet your guests when they arrive with the passes. Thanks for your cooperation.

Mini Golf: The course is open during the store hours listed below. Our mini golf course is \$5.00 per game per person, along with a \$5.00 deposit per person for the club and ball. A friendly reminder, we DO NOT allow you to use your own club and ball on our course.

Golf Course: The golf course is open daily from dawn to dusk for members and pre-paid tickets, apart from league play and tournaments (which are posted on the Happy Hills Resort Golf Facebook page). Everyone must sign the book on the deck when entering the Golf Course when the Par-Tee Shack is not open.

Sharing Library: Our Sharing Library is set up in the store with a variety of books and DVD's. Stop in and take a book or DVD and share a book or DVD.

Sunday Yard Work: A reminder that on Sundays you are not permitted to do any construction, use power tools or lawn mowers. Please respect your neighbours and keep the park peaceful on Sundays.

Garbage and Recycling: Please make sure all large items (i.e., mattresses, BBQs etc.) are taken home and NOT left at our dumpsters. Large items can be taken to Salford Oxford County Waste Management OR Woodstock EnvironDepot. There are fees to deposit at both locations, but some are free to residents of Oxford County. We would also appreciate that you break down your boxes to maximize space in our recycle bins.

Pet Policy: All dog owners in the park MUST have their pets on a leash – even when on your site. We have a leash free dog park where your dog can run free but that is the ONLY area where this is permitted. If the dogs are reported off leash, you will be asked to remove your dog from the park. Also please remember to clean up after your dogs! Plastic bags for your dog's waste can be found at the dog parks.
