Garbage and Recycling: Please make sure all large items (i.e., mattresses, BBQs etc.) are taken home and NOT left at our dumpsters. We would also appreciate that you break down your boxes to maximize space in our recycle bins.

Pet policy: All dog owners in the park MUST always have their pets on a leash – even when on your site. We have a leash free dog park where they can run free but that is the ONLY area where this is permitted. If the dogs are reported off leash, you will be asked to remove your dog from the park. Also please remember to clean up after your dogs! Plastic bags for your dog's waste can be found at the dog park.

Helmets in the Park: Our Park Rules state children under 18 are required to wear helmets by law. We want everyone to be safe here at Happy Hills!

Just a reminder to make sure to park on your own site and not on the side of the roads! We have a busy weekend ahead of us and can expect a lot of traffic coming in and out of the park. If vehicles can stay on their own sites that would be greatly appreciated.
